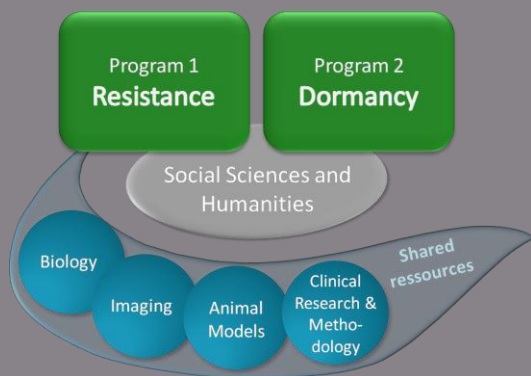

The ONCOLille consortium gathers outstanding strengths of researchers in basic, translational and clinical research with successful developments in areas of **biology, imaging, animal models, methodology** and **human science**. It counts:

- ✓ 18 academic and clinical research laboratories of the Lille area
- ✓ a community of more than 300 people conducting **2 main research programs**:

**Program 1 - tumor and host resistance to loco-regional treatments** in the field of head and neck, esogastric, liver and gynecological tumors,

**Program 2 - tumor dormancy and persistence after treatment** in the field of hematology, melanoma and prostate cancer.

As the North-Pas de Calais region displays the highest rate of cancer incidence and mortality in France and one of the highest in Europe, ONCOLille provides a **real opportunity to implement a comprehensive cancer center in north of France**.

The research programs integrate numerous local and international **collaborations** involving basic and clinical research teams. Partnerships are undertaken with local and regional biotechnology companies through the Eursanté economic development agency.

**Dissemination of knowledge** will be directed towards patients, general practitioners and healthcare providers in the field of care, adapted follow up and professional reinsertion.

The research programs integrate **basic, translational, clinical and social sciences and humanities researches**, aiming to rapidly benefit the patients with better treatments and improved quality of life.
